#### **Fast Forward/Pause/Rewind - A talk by producer Gareth Jones plus Q&A**

Long time Mute collaborator Gareth Jones (Depeche Mode, Erasure, Liars and many others) will give an overview of studios and recording technologies as they have evolved and improved (?) in his time with Mute, touching on Analog, Digital, Tape and Vinyl.

#### **An Introduction To The Science Of Mastering - A talk by Stefan Betke aka Pole**

Highly influential electronic producer Stefan Betke has also been a mastering engineer since 1996, initially at Berlin's Dubplates and Mastering and then with his own ~scape mastering studio to which he has recently added a Neumann VMS 70 cutting lathe to offer vinyl.

#### **'Do you love me like I love you: The Boatman's Call' - A film by Iain Forsyth and Jane Pollard plus Q&A with the film makers hosted by Kris Needs**

This world premiere about the landmark album by Nick Cave and the Bad Seed features a compelling collage of famous, infamous and unknown individuals talking directly to camera about what the music of Nick Cave and The Bad Seeds means to them.

#### **ON/OFF; Mark Stewart From Pop Group To Maffia - A documentary directed by Toni Schifer**

Mark Stewart first made his presence felt as the front man for The Pop Group in the late 1970's. He went on to form his own band The Maffia whose mix of dub, funk and electronic overload pre-empted techno and drum & bass by years. The film retraces the singer's steps and paths from the early days of The Pop Group right up to the present.
